### WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

The funds raised at AIDS Walk Los Angeles support the services provided by APLA Health and more than 20 other L.A. County AIDS service organizations.

# WHY AREN'T MY CASH AND CHECK CONTRIBUTIONS SHOWING ON MY PAGE?

While credit card and paypal donations made through the website will automatically appear on a walker's personal fundraising web page, cash and check donations, or "offline donations," require walkers to update their fundraising web pages by logging in and choosing the "Enter Offline Donations" option in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

### WHAT ARE GOLD TEAMS?

Gold Teams are the top 20 fundraising teams from last year, announced annually.

In recognition of their outstanding efforts,
Gold Teams enjoy several perks, including their own
exclusive meeting area on the day of the event, an
exclusive Sign-In Area, and a professional team photo
taken on the day of the event.

### IF SOMEONE REGISTERED AS AN INDIVIDUAL CAN THEY JOIN MY TEAM?

Pre-registered walkers can still be part of your team.

phone number, and email address (if available) and ask to
have them transferred.

### IS THERE A PARTICIPATION FEE?

AIDS Walk Los Angeles does not require walkers to raise a minimum amount of money. However, we encourage everyone to set a fundraising goal and do their best to achieve it. Additionally, fundraising walkers for AIDS Walk Los Angeles are eligible for several Fundraising Awards.

# WHAT ARE MATCHING GIFT PROGRAMS?

Matching gift programs are established by many companies with the intention of supporting nonprofit organizations by matching contributions made by their employees.

Ask your human resources representative about your employer's corporate giving policies and whether they have a matching gift program.

### ABOUT APLA HEALTH

APLA Health's mission is to achieve health care equity and promote well-being for the LGBT and other underserved communities and people living with and affected by HIV. It is a nonprofit, federally qualified health center serving more than 14,000 people annually. APLA Health provides 20 different services from 15 locations throughout Los Angeles County, including: medical, dental, and behavioral health care; PrEP counseling and management; health education and HIV prevention; and STD screening and treatment. For people living with HIV, it offers housing support; benefits counseling; home health care; and the Vance North Necessities of Life Program food pantries; among several other critically needed services.



Funds raised by walkers (with a few exceptions)
will directly benefit APLA Health.

Last year 1,147 teams raised \$1,461,412, more than 60% of all AIDS
Walk Funds.

Founded in 1982, APLA Health has become a leader as an AIDS service organization. APLA Health is dedicated to serving men, women, and families living with and affected by HIV and AIDS throughout L.A. county.
