THESE ARE PERILOUS TIMES FOR CARING COMMUNITIES.

Recent actions of the new administration have made this an especially hazardous time for people living with HIV/AIDS.

- **Repeal of the Affordable Care Act** could throw thousands of HIV-positive people off of insurance, and inhibit their access to life-saving care and drugs.
- The new administration has vowed to cut off federal grants in sanctuary cities that have pledged to protect undocumented immigrants. Cities in New Jersey like Jersey City, Newark, New Brunswick, Plainfield, and Trenton – all areas with Hyacinth offices that serve our clients most in need – could be affected. This is a threat to the wellbeing of thousands of New Jerseyans living with HIV/AIDS, no matter their country of origin.
- All information regarding the National HIV/AIDS Strategy has been scrubbed from the White House website. Meanwhile, the Office of National AIDS Policy has been left unstaffed for weeks.

In response, our message must be clear, and our clear actions must follow: **Not in New Jersey. Not on our watch.**

As federal safety nets are frayed, **the funds we raise** at AIDS Walk New York will ensure that **Hyacinth** can beat back any and all attempts to reverse the progress we have made in the fight against **HIV/AIDS**. Your efforts will help Hyacinth continue to boldly advocate on behalf of its clients regardless of race, gender, or immigration status.

Respond to these threats. **Resist** attacks on our public health, liberty, and equality. **Reach out** to your networks to help us raise vital funds. Take a stand *against* rollbacks in lifesaving advancements, and *for* our community.
