31st ANNUAL AIDS WALK NEW YORK WORLD'S LARGEST HIV/AIDS FUNDRAISING EVENT

What: This year marks the 31st annual AIDS Walk New York, the east coast's first and the world's largest AIDS

fundraising event. The event will raise vital funds for GMHC and 40 other AIDS service organizations in

the tri-state area.

This year's AIDS Walk New York continues to keep the public engaged with the HIV/AIDS crisis through community-driven outreach, a strong social media presence, and, as always, a compelling street campaign.

AIDS Walk New York is one of the largest, most diverse, and highly anticipated annual events in New York City. Last year, 30,000 walkers and 2,500 volunteers raised more than \$4.9 million for HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment, and advocacy programs. Since its inception, the event has raised more than \$144 million to fight AIDS in the tri-state area, and the AIDS Walk movement has raised more than a half-billion dollars nationwide.

Where: The 10k (6.2-mile) AIDS Walk route begins and ends in Central Park.

GMHC also advocates for stronger public policies at the local, state and federal level with the goal of ending AIDS as an epidemic in New York State by 2020.
