Below are some sample fundraising ideas to help your team raise funds in a fun and creative way.

Text-a-thon: send personalized text messages with your personal or team fundraising link to family and friends.

Shave Your Head: As a result of reaching your fundraising goal or simply to raise awareness. Be sure to share this on social media and create a buzz.



Valentine's Daysing-a-grams: donors get a team of singers from the school to "deliver."

Superbowl/March Madness Fundraiser: set up your own event and ask for a donation to attend, or ask a local sports bar if they'll let you use their establishment to throw a viewing party.

10,000 steps a day challenge: have participants raise money for committing to walk 10,000 steps a day on certain days or for a specific time period.

Awareness Bracelets: be creative, make them and sell them!



Prime Parking Spot: for a week (or month), awarded to whoever raises the most money during an allotted time.

Cookbook: collect favorite recipes, produce a book and sell it with proceeds going to your team.

Class/Department Competition: the group that raises the most gets a prize determined by the captain.
